Hence, this grant will generate economic activities in your rural and urban centers.

The presence of the Hon. Prime Minister to personally hand out cheques is a testament that your Fijian Government prioritizes the growth of Micro, Small and Medium enterprises as they ensure inclusive economic development for our nation.

And as for any investment, your Government expects return on its investment which should be in the form of growth of your respective businesses, development of your communities and an increase in the contribution of the MSME sector towards our economy.
